SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Entries will be accepted from <u>amateur or professional players</u>, who are members of a recognized Golf Union. The team must be composed of <u>a male and a female and at least one amateur player</u>.

HANDICAP LIMIT: 11.4 for females and 10.4 for males.

<u>ALL FOREIGN PARTICPANTS</u> are to submit both a proof of handicap certified by the players Golf Union and a valid health questionnaire to complete their online entry. See required documents <u>here.</u>

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO 64 TEAMS (Wild Card included)

63 Entries will be decided using:

• The aggregate index of each team, the index of 0 will be taken into account for a professional player and then by the date of online enrolment.

1 wild card will be awarded to the Saint Germain Golf Club to enter up a team of 2 member players.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

Qualifying stage – Foursome / Stroke play / 18 holes

First day: Qualifying stage

The first **16 teams** are qualified for the final stage and are placed into a match play bracket according to their rank. *If the number of teams is lower than the number of teams qualified for the final stage, a round of stroke play will still be organized to compose the match play bracket.* Ties for the last spot(s) will be decided taking into account the last 9 holes, the last 6, the last 3 and the last hole, if the tie remains, hole by hole going back up.

Final stage – Foursome / match play / 18 holes / 2 rounds per day Second day: Round of 16 & quarterfinals Third and final day: Semi-finals and final

Men and women will play from the same tee-markers.

ENTRY FORM & ENTRY FEES (60€ per player for non ffgolf-licence holders)

We, French Golf Federation, must receive the online entry form no later than September 10th, 2025, midnight.

Attention: Any player may change his / her partner after the closing date, BUT, even if the team was in the FIELD, the team could be moved back in the WAITING LIST.
