

2019 FRENCH TOUR QUALIFYING SCHOOL

1st Stage: 12th and 13th March 2019

Final Stage: from 16th to 18th March 2019

(For all stages: entries close Tuesday 26th February 2019)

PREAMBLE

The French Professional Commission (formed by representatives of the French Golf Federation and the French PGA) will organize the 2019 French Tour Qualifying School.

The Qualifying School will be opened to the foreign players filling the conditions of eligibility.

At the conclusion of the 2019 French Tour Qualifying School, the ranking will then allow to determine the categories member players of the 2019 French Tour.

REGULATIONS

1. **FORMAT**

The Qualifying School will be conducted in two stages of stroke play.

FIRST STAGE

(36 holes) – 12th and 13th March 2019

This is for all applicants **except** those who are exempt and qualified directly to the **Final Stage**.

First Stage will be played on **Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th March** at the following venue:

All applicants are advised that Thursday 14th March may be used as a full playing day.

The maximum field size will be **78** players.

Priority may be determined by the entry fee date of payment.

Minimum 15 players will be qualified to the Final Stage. The number of players qualifying to proceed to the Final Stage will be announced after the start of the first round of First Stage. In case of ties, a hole by hole playoff will determine the selected players. Playoff will take place as soon as possible after the end of regular play.

FINAL STAGE

(54 holes) – from 16th to 18th March 2019

The following players are exempt from the First Stage and eligible for the Final Stage (**automatic exemptions**):

- a. Players finishing beyond 40th place of the French National Order of Merit on the 19th November 2018.
- b. Amateur players who took part in the 2018 Men World Team Championships, Men or Boys European Team Championships.
- c. Players with the "1st series elite" status in 2019 in France.

Attention:

The French Professional Commission can spread out the criteria of exemption of the First Stage (**optional exemptions**), in the number of available spots, to the:

- d. to players who have a category on the Challenge Tour for 2019 (from category 1 to 17).
- e. to players who have a category on the Alps Tour for 2019 (from category 0 to 8).
- f. to the players who took part in the "Stage 2" of the European Tour Qualifying School 2018, according to tournament ranking.
- g. to the players who took part in the Final Stage of the Alps Tour Qualifying School 2018, according to tournament ranking.
- h. to former winners of tournaments listed on the French Tour schedule.
- i. to players who had a category on the French Tour in 2018 or in 2019 (from category 1 to 39).

Final Stage will be played **from Saturday 16th to Monday 18th March 2019** at the following venue:

Players are advised that Tuesday 19th March may be used as a full playing day.

Maximum field size will be **78** players.

The Final Stage is scheduled to be played over 54 holes. After 36 holes, the field will be cut down to the leading **40** players and ties who will play the last round.

After 54 holes, players who make the cut and ties will be ranked according to their scores.

All tied scores shall be ranked by the best last 18 holes, 9, 6, 3, and last hole.

The final ranking will determine the member players of the following 2019 French Tour categories:

- **The winner of the French Tour Qualifying School:** Category 17 (access to all the tournaments sanctioned "Challenge Tour" and "French Tour" in France).

- **The leading 5 players of the French Tour Qualifying School:** Category 20 (access to minimum two "Challenge Tour" tournaments in France and all the "French Tour" tournaments in France).
- **The leading 20 players of the French Tour Qualifying School:** Category 25 (access to all the "French Tour" tournaments in France).
- **Players making the cut of the Final Stage and finishing beyond 20th place and ties of the Final Result:** Category 34 (reserve category).

Every effort will be made to complete three rounds but a result shall be declared even if only two rounds are played.

If at least two rounds cannot be played, the Final Stage shall be partially or totally rescheduled.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- (1) All male professional players.
- (2) All male amateur players, with a handicap below or equal to 1.4 (handicap has to be certified by the National Golf organization for foreign players) at the closing date.
- (3) French players must have taken their ffgolf license for 2019 and provide a medical certificate.

3. ENTRY ONLINE / PAYMENT

All applicants: **290 Euros**. This payment covers entry to **all** stages.

All entry registration and entry fee payment must be done and paid on <https://cpi.ffgolf.org/fr/>

Please note that your entry will not be processed until your full entry fee has been received and banked.

4. ENTRY DEADLINE

For all stages, entries will close on **Tuesday 26th February 2019.**

5. WITHDRAWALS

All withdrawals must be notified to the ffgolf.

If a player withdraws prior to the appropriate closing date his entry fee will be refunded in full.

If a player withdraws after the appropriate closing date, without competing, he will be refunded only **180 Euros**. (NB: No exceptions).

If a player is absent on the tee without notification, no refund will be given and he may face disciplinary action subject to circumstances.

Once an entrant has teed off, refund of entry is not possible.

NOTE: refunds will not be issued until close of entries.

6. NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY

Once an application has been accepted, applicants will be e-mailed a confirmation of entry. The receipt of the payment of the entry fee will be available at the Tournament Office. The field of the First Stage and the exempted players to this Stage will be available on **Thursday 28th February 2019** on the official website (<http://ftr.ocs-sport.com/tic/tmtic.cgi>) and will be sent by e-mail.

The ffgolf is not responsible for your entry and **it is the applicant's responsibility to verify his status in the Qualifying Tournament.**

7. GENERAL POLICY

The French Professional Commission reserves the right to change or amend the above format, conditions and schedule of play and also to reject application for entry at any time (including during the First Stage).

Conduct unbecoming a professional or non-competitive performance in a previous Qualifying School can be a basis for the rejection of the application to enter by the French Professional Commission.

Note: The decision about the new grooves regulation does not apply on the 2019 French Tour Qualifying School.

8. JOINING THE FRENCH TOUR

To obtain full membership rights, players who are eligible for membership in 2019 French Tour categories, must have paid their membership fee to PGA France and ffgolf license before the 31st March 2019.

Foreign players will not be included on the French National Order of Merit 2019. They will be eligible to join the French Tour in 2020 categories only by obtaining a category by French Tour Qualifying School 2020.
